## Pets travelling in vehicles

Your pet can stay in your vehicle at no extra charge, providing the conditions within the vehicle are comfortable and safe.

- No more than 2 medium dogs inside a car/ute/SUV
- No more than 3 medium dogs in a campervan/ motorhome/caravan
- Dogs must be inside the vehicle and not on the back deck of the ute or truck
- All windows which can be opened should be lowered leaving a gap of at least 7cm.

## Book a kennel

If you are travelling by foot, you can bring your pet along by booking a kennel in advance.

- Kennels can be occupied by 1 large dog (standing back height of 60cm)
- Limit of 2 dogs in a single kennel is permitted (standing back height under 60cm).

## Dog exercise areas

If your dog needs a run around before or after the journey, you'll find dog exercise areas near our terminals at:

# Working dogs travelling in crates or boxes

Air does NOT flow as well on ships decks as it does on the open road. Ventilation requirements are to avoid heat stress, which can be fatal.

- Dogs must be able to stand, turnaround and lie down with a natural posture comfortably
- No more than 2 dogs (standing back height under 60cm) in any crate or single subdivision
- Dogs with a standing back height exceeding 60cm must travel in their own crate
- Kennels can be booked in advance if numbers exceed the above.

# Applying for an exemption

Accredited pet transport companies are permitted to transport more than three animals inside their vehicle, provided they meet all the requirements.

If you are travelling with more dogs, you need to apply for an exemption by emailing us at:

- are sick or injured.
- · are in their final trimester of pregnancy
- have given birth in the past 14 weeks.
- are under 8 weeks of age.
