- This information provides Limits for Dangerous Goods before you need to complete a dangerous goods declaration.

- Please be advised Interislander does **NOT** allow any Dangerous Goods to be taken on board as hand luggage

Class: 1 Explosives 	<p>1.4S – UN 0012, UN0014, UN0044, UN0055 Limited to small firearm cartridges</p> <p>1.3G - Distress flares UN 0092, UN0195</p> <p>1.4G - Hand flares UN0191, Smoke flares UN0197 and Signal cartridges UN0312, store brought fireworks</p> <p>Limit of 50KG gross weight includes packaging</p>	<p>1.3G, 1.4G - Prohibited</p> <p>1.4S – UN 0012, UN0014, UN0044, UN0055 Limited to small firearm cartridges only.</p> <p>Limit of 2KG gross weight includes packaging</p>
Class: 2 Gases 	<p>2.1: Flammable Gases Limited to less than 50L water capacity Max Cylinder size 9KG (25 Litres)</p> <p>Example: LPG</p> <p>2.2: Non-Flammable - Limited to 90L water capacity.</p> <p><i>Note: Scuba dive tanks limit 200L water capacity</i></p>	<p>2.1: Flammable Gases – limited up to 450g. Example: Tramping gas cannister</p> <p>2.2: Non-Flammable - Limited to 25L water capacity Scuba dive tanks limit 50L water capacity (4 X 12L cylinders)</p>
Class: 3 Flammable Liquids 	<p>With a flash point below 23C limited to under 5 litres. With a flashpoint between 23C - 60C * limited to under 100 litres.</p> <p>Examples: Paint, Petrol, Kerosene in jerrycan</p> <p>*Flashpoint refers to the temperature where the vapour of a flammable liquid will ignite.</p>	<p>Prohibited</p> <p><i>Note: Items under 23% alcohol content are not treated as a dangerous good</i></p>
Class: 4 Flammable Solids 	<p>4.1: Up to 5kg of certain flammable solids may be carried</p> <p>Hay: Limited to less than 60kg, must be completely covered and dry.</p> <p>4.3: Limited to 1kg (solids), 1L (liquid)</p>	<p>Prohibited</p>

<p>Class: 5.1 Oxidizing Materials</p> 	<p>Up to 5KG (solids) or 5L (liquids) Packing group 11 or 111</p>	<p>Prohibited</p>
<p>Class: 5.2 Organic Peroxides</p> 	<p>Type A: Prohibited</p> <p>Type: B – limited to 5kg (Solids), 5L (liquids)</p> <p>Type: C, D, E, F – limited to 10kg (Solids), 5 L (liquids)</p>	<p>Prohibited</p>
<p>Class: 6.1 Toxic Substances</p> 	<p>Up to 5kg (solids), 5L (liquids) may be carried.</p>	<p>Prohibited</p>
<p>Class: 6.2 Infectious Substances</p> 	<p>Example: Portable toilet effluent, septic tank waste and sewage screening sludge.</p> <p>Up to 100 litres (or one portable toilet)</p>	<p>Prohibited</p>
<p>Class: 7 Radioactive Materials</p> 	<p>Prohibited</p>	<p>Prohibited</p>
<p>Class: 8 Corrosives</p> 	<p>Batteries Acid: UN2794 & Batteries Alkali: UN2797 Limited to less than 250L (measured by volume of battery case)</p> <p>UN3028: Dry Batteries containing Potassium Limited to less than 250g</p> <p>All other corrosive substances: Limited to less than 5kg (solids) or 5L (liquids).</p>	<p>Prohibited</p>
<p>Class: 9 Miscellaneous</p>	<p>Up to 5KG (solids), 5L (liquids) of a particular substance may be carried.</p>	<p>Prohibited</p>



Mixed Load Max Quantity: Max combined mix load of items is 250 being liquids (Litres) or solids (kg) in total.

*If a combined total of liquids and solids is over the 250 limits, then goods **MUST** be carried as **FREIGHT CARGO ONLY**. (cannot travel in passenger vehicle)*

Note: Diesel with a flashpoint of over 60C can be carried with a limit of 100 Litres
